Subject: Certification Pursuant to SEC Rule 242.807 – Wematch Live SBSEF Compliance Manual

Dear Assistant Secretary,

Pursuant to Rule 242.807 of Regulation SE under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act"), Wematch SBSEF hereby submits for self-certification amendments to its Compliance Manual.

Wematch SBSEF is filing an updated version of its Compliance Manual. The amendments reflect updates to the SBSEF's compliance policies, procedures, and controls designed to support compliance with the Exchange Act, Regulation SE, and the rules of the SBSEF.

The amended Compliance Manual is scheduled to become effective on July 1, 2026.

The purpose of the amended Compliance Manual is to maintain and enhance the policies and procedures through which Wematch SBSEF satisfies its obligations under the Exchange Act and Regulation SE.

In particular, the amendments support compliance with **17 CFR § 242.819 (Core Principle 2 – Compliance with Rules)**, which requires a security-based swap execution facility to establish and enforce compliance with its rules and maintain procedures designed to ensure compliance with the Exchange Act and Commission regulations applicable to security-based swap execution facilities.

Pursuant to Rule 242.807(a)(6), Wematch SBSEF represents that no substantive opposing views were expressed by governing board members, committees, participants, market participants, or other interested parties with respect to the proposed rule amendment.

Wematch SBSEF respectfully requests confidential treatment of the Compliance Manual and related materials submitted in connection with this filing to the extent permitted under applicable law and Commission rules.
